Background

- The aviation sector has faced **unprecedented challenges** since the outbreak of the COVID-19 virus
- This fundamentally impacts the sub regional **economy** and the **livelihoods of its communities**
- **Collaboration** with local stakeholders would be key to supporting the sector and the sub-region in its recovery

Purpose of the Heathrow Local Recovery Roundtables

- To understand from members the key **challenges and opportunities** for local recovery and **what's needed** from Heathrow
- To **identify shared messaging** on aviation impacts and interventions
- To **develop**, with the aim of publishing, a **sub-regional plan for Heathrow** in collaboration with local stakeholders recommending the interventions that will support the recovery

Bringing together 70 stakeholders:

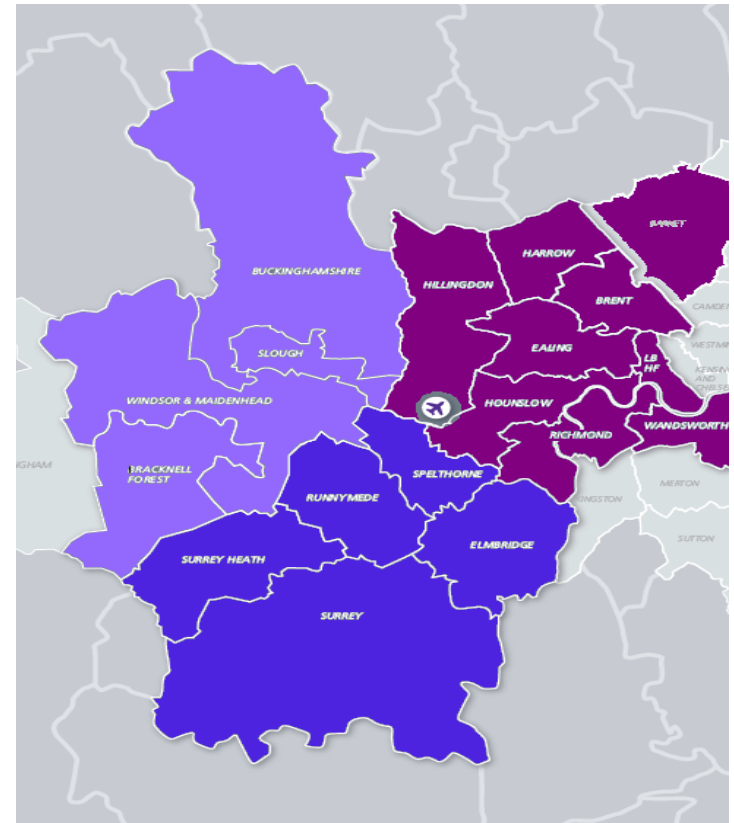

Outcome of the roundtables

- Pre-engagement
- Four priority themes:
 - ❖ Skills, employment and education
 - ❖ Supply chain opportunities for local business
 - ❖ Enabling a green recovery
 - ❖ Surface Access
- Over 40 individual recommendations

September - First Heathrow Local Recovery Forum

- Agreed the policy asks to present to government
- Agreed to take forward a set of priority recommendations emerging from roundtable discussions

- Finalise the priority recommendations
- Present government asks.
- Finalise and publish Heathrow's Local Recovery Plan (October)
- Co-ordinate communications with local stakeholders to highlight the key impacts and seek support
